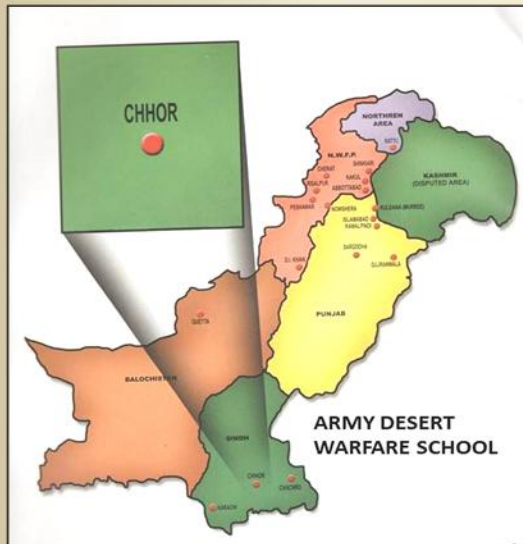


ARMY DESERT WARFARE SCHOOL

Location

Army Desert Warfare School is located at Chhor which is 165 kilometers from Hyderabad and 360 kilometers from Karachi. Chhor is linked with Hyderabad, Mirpur Khas - Umerkot by road / rail. Umerkot is the last major town which is 20 kilometers from Chhor.



Chhor is a Sindhi word, which means "End of Green Belt".

Climate

Chhor has a hot desert climate with very hot summers and pleasant winters. However, during summers the night remain pleasant with blowing winds.

Training Spectrum / Scope

- Educate the trainees on characteristics of desert and its effects on troops
- Enhance students skills regarding conduct of operations in desert terrain at platoon / company level with in framework of Battalion.
- Enhance the ability to trainees to survive in desert terrain.
- Achieve proficiency in navigation techniques by using conventional and improvised methods in desert.
- Enhance the sustainability of the trainees in the desert with in available means.
- Improve knowledge of fauna and flora.

Courses

- 5 x DWC (Desert Warfare Course)
- Integrated Course of Officers / Junior Commissioned Officers / Soldiers / Foreign Trainees.
- Desert Warfare Training to 2 x OACC (Officers Advance Commando Course) ex Special Service Group

Training Facilities

Replicas of Sun Compass, Improvised Compass & Clock. These are handy training aids and are very useful for student to enhance their understanding about navigation.



Desert Room. A room where animals, birds and reptiles commonly found in desert are kept in stuffed / preserved form for easy assimilation of students.

Planetarium. This is a training room, the ceiling of which depicts the sky with various constellations / star. It is a very useful training aid for understanding the Astro Nav and different constellations / stars.

Desert Nursery. The school has dev desert nursery which is embellished with most species of plants found in desert. It helps students in understanding the characteristics & usage of these plants.

Outdoor Training. Outdoor training area of the institution spread over 240 sq kms with 437 Navigation pillars. There are 12 x types of Navigation exercises planned during one course including 15 x day and 5 x night Navigation Exercise. During outdoor exercise students are put across through practical application of Minor Operations / Major Operations in the desert.

Accommodation

We provide luxurious accommodation with all allied facilities, where 25-30 officers can be accommodated at a time.



Tourist Attractions

Karachi. Karachi is the 7th largest urban agglomeration in the world and 2nd largest in muslim world. Quaid-e- Azam International Airport Karachi is at a distance of 5 hours drive from Chhor. Karachi is the largest city in Pakistan. It is main sea port and financial centre of Pakistan. Karachi is also known as 'City of Lights' due to city's night life as the city which never sleeps at night. Famous tourist attractions including Quaid-e-Azam Mausoleum & attractive beaches like, Monora Island, Sandpit/ Hawke's Bay / Paradise point / Nathia Gali / French Beach & Cape Monze.

Hyderabad. The second largest city in Sindh and one of the largest cities of Pakistan lies at 2 hours' drive from Chhor. The Kalhora Fort was constructed in 1768 as part of Hyderabad. Various tombs are also found here, noteworthy is the Tomb of Ghulam Shah Kalhoro.
