CAPTIVATING KULDANA



Army School of Logistics (ASL)



History

- Kuldana was found and established as military cantonment in 1863. Number of British Regiments camped here. Prominent amongst those were Bedfordshire Regiment, Devonshire Regiment, West Yorkshire (Prince of Wales's Own) Regiment and so on.
- 60 bed British Hospital, a Chapel, Centurion old British cemetery, cinema and a rackets court are few of the old landmarks. Many 19th century buildings have been preserved in their original state and their graceful style is a living testimony to the architectural aesthetics of that period.
- Besides military training, Kuldana was also a hub of recreational activities for the British Army owing to its pristine location. The British carved some essence of England in Murree, making Kuldana their home away from home.
- In 1940, Royal Indian Army Service Corps School was established here, for one year only. Later, "Signal Training Centre HQ" was established on 13th September 1947 at Kuldana. In 1952, Army School of Administration was established here. Army School of Logistics was established at Abbotabad (To be Camp) and was shifted to Kuldana in 1975, amalgamating the two.

Kuldana Attractions

Pakistan Gallery. By careful restoration of 130 years old, British era building, a unique Photo Gallery (Pakistan Gallery) has been established at Kuldana. This gallery is one of its kind in Pakistan and represents the ravishing beauty and rich culture of the country and is certainly one of the most attractive features at school. The gallery show cases digital paintings and pictures of Pakistan history, culture and beauty from North to South.

- **Kuldana Army Public School.** This 19th Century building houses Army Public School that offers quality education/grooming to students from pre-school to Senior Secondary Level.
- **Kuldana Library.** This centurion aged building houses more than 5000 books on logistics, management and subjects of general interest. It is also digitally linked to National Defense University library.
- **Telegraph and Post Office.** It was established in 1888 and remained under NWFP and Kashmir Division till partition with preserved documents. This 130 years old building still functions as Kuldana Post Office.
- **Kawish.** This retail crafts store is one place to wall hangings etc. Pakistani souvenirs, Kuldana souvenirs, hand knit woolen garments and other utility items are also available here.
- **Guest Rooms.** Kuldana is one place where the care and comfort of our guests is our top priority. We offer continuous electric supply, free Wi-fi Kuldana also means relaxation and adventure. Find serenity and activity together.
- **Wildlife.** The thick Kuldana forests are home to many animal species such as leopard, Barking Deer and Yellow Throated Marten etc. Bird species include yellow-billed blue magpie, blue whistling thrush, dove, Eurasian blue tit, Plum Head Parakeet and Hawks etc.
- **Mesmerizing View Points.** Kuldana offers many spellbinding locations which take you far from the hustle and bustle of urban living and exemplify the practical meaning of tranquillity. Sit in solitude and enjoy the breathtaking landscapes of Kashmir and Islamabad.

- **The British Cemetery.** There are two cemeteries at Kuldana. The smaller and older contains several graves of privates of The 4th Battalion Rifle Brigade. The graves of this cemetery are no longer traceable. The New Cemetery is comparatively bigger in size and dates from 1885. It contains over 20 graves, includes the grave of Major Harold Anthony Kenyon (Military Cross) son of Major General Richard Kenyon (Director General Ordnance in India from 1919-1920). The track from Cheeta morh westwards leads to this Cemetery.
- **Kuldana Trail.** A 45-minutes hiking track, which originates from Gordon Huts near Army Public School. The track winds through a thick pine forest where one can experience nature and spectacular sights of hills and valleys. On the way, visitors can enjoy singing birds and whispering pines. Located in the middle is Ayub Point, to enjoy solitude and perhaps read a book.
- **Cricket Ground.** The old Recreational Ground at the end of Kuldana trail. A Plateau surrounded by tall pine trees. A favorite place for trekkers and players alike. South west end of the ground is adorned with mystically carved rock memorial of 1st Battalion West Yorkshire Regiment (1910).

Adventure Sports / Recreational Activities

- **Firing.** Escape the ordinary and test your country. Beside many other calibers of Small Arms, Shoot at the flying skeet too.
- **Skiing.** Visit our newly developed ski slopes "If you are not crashing, you aren't skiing!" Wear your gear and ski on.

- **Archery.** Test the strength of your arms and explore your passion for an ancient skill of archery. If you hit the mark, bravo, you are as good as those who lived here a thousand years ago.
- **Cycling.** Explore jungle tracks for mountain biking, from 1 km to 4kms in length.
- **Pathfinder.** Finding and making your way through a stretch of 6kms jungle tracks is an unbeatable experience for all ages.
- **Hurdle Race.** Test your stamina in 500 meters hurdle race, in jungle environment.
- **Camping.** The best place to enjoy camping, in a secure and serene setting is the "Cricket Ground" amidst two rock memorials carved a hundred years apart. (Camping equipment can be obtained from In charge Adventure Club).
- **Outdoor / Indoor Games.** Bring out the sportsman in you and test your stamina at 7000 ft by playing football, squash, tennis, basketball, badminton and table tennis etc.
