

## History

- On independent, the Pakistani element of Corps of Indian Military Police reached Abbotabad as a separate entity in November 1947 and was named "Corps of Mil Police" (CMP).
- CMP was disbanded on 1st March 1948 as it was considered uneconomical to maintain it as a separate Corps.
- The Corps was re-raised on 1st February 1949 with its School Centre & Record at Quetta.
- Brig Hill was first Provost Marshal and Col Grant Taylor was first Commandant of the CMP School Centre & Record.
- CMP School Centre & Record were shifted from Quetta to DI Khan on 21st Apr 1954.
- In 1955, the streamlining of all the centres was envisaged by General Headquarters. This resulted in the amalgamation of CMP School Centre & Record with MODC Centre on 7 May 1956 and re-designated as "CMP/MODC Cen".
- The year 1967 mark an important landmark in the history of CMP when its school C&R were bifurcated from the MODC (now DSG and redesigned as CMP School C&R and it exists today as a separate entity.
- CMP inherited its red beret from Royal Military Police & present emblem was designed by Brig Gulzar Ahmed (Colonel Commandant CMP) which means to enforce and correct.
